

Below are the applications and FAQs for entry in the Sustainable Art Show, Fashion Show, and sign-ups to model.

Instructions:

Complete the form corresponding to your entry piece(s) (i.e. Art and/or Fashion) or if you wish to volunteer as a model. To complete the form, click on the area where you wish to enter text and a box will appear. Type the necessary information. Save and submit forms electronically to l_kramer2@u.pacific.edu. In the subject header of the submittal email type your last name and the forms you completed.

FAQs:

When is the entry deadline? The entry deadline is Friday, April 5th at 5pm.

Where do I submit my application? Please submit your entry to l_kramer2@u.pacific.edu. In the subject header type your last name, and type of entries.

What is the difference between the Art Show and Fashion Show? The art show is an artist's rendition of sustainability, earth, and social justice. Art will be displayed from 4-7pm. The Fashion Show consists of clothing made from recycled, "up-cycled," re-used, and sustainable materials. The fashion show will take place 5pm.

Where will the event take place? The event is located near at Art building and Geosciences building near the Ted and Chris Robb Garden.

What time are the events? The Art show will be from 4pm-7pm and people will be able to move in and out of the Art show as they please. The fashion show will take place at 5pm outside the front door of the Geosciences building.

Who is eligible to participate? Pacific students and interested community members are eligible to submit entries into either or both shows. We encourage individuals and groups to collaborate and submit to the EcoShow.

Where can I find used and unique items to create an entry? A number of departments on campus have interesting materials that may be re-used to create a fashion piece or art work. Some of these include ceramics, pharmacy, and the mailroom. Contact the departments or s_eller@pacific to learn more about recycled items on campus.

What it means to be sustainable:

Sustainability entails practices for the creation, use and disposal of a piece to be done in such a way that can be continued for generations to come. There are three components of sustainability: Financial, Environmental, and Social. Financial sustainability requires money to be spent in a responsible manner. Environmental sustainability involves being conscious of the impact upon our natural resources. Social responsibility looks at the conditions of the human labor required to make and recycle the materials being used.

Eligibility:

- Entries must be original, entirely the work of the participant(s)
- Entries must not be copies or based on copyrighted materials

Accepted Works:

- Method of display should be discussed on an individual basis. Participants are required to bring their own specific stands in the case that a table is not suitable.
- If interested in selling artwork, artist must agree to, upon sale, a 15% commission in the posted price/value

Photography:

The University of the Pacific reserves the right to photograph entries for the purpose of documentation, education, and publicity.

- Entries will be selected from applications (include a picture)
