There is an Engineering/Computer Science Fee of \$150.00 per semester for School of Engineering and Computer Sciences (SOECS) students. **Student Health Insurance is charged to all students registered. Monthly Plan - Three payments due: January 1, February 1 and March 1. - Five payments due: January 1, February 1, March 1, April 1 and May 1.</p> <p>Semester Plan - Pharmacy & Health Sciences Spring - One payment due by December 1, 2021. Monthly Plan - Four payments due: December 1, January 1, February 1, and March 1.</p> <p>Semester Plan - Pharmacy & Health Sciences Summer - One payment due by April 1, 2022. Monthly Plan - Four payments due: April 1, May 1, June 1, and July 1.</p> <p>Enrollment in the monthly payment plan requires a Deferred Fee of \$25 per semester for 3 months and \$75 per semester for 5 months (General). Enrollment in the monthly payment plan requires a Deferred Fee of \$75 per term for 4 months (Pharmacy & Health Sciences).
