

Tuition Exchange for Pacific Employees



ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES

Full-time and part-time employees must complete one year of continuous service at Pacific by September 1 of the academic year to apply for Tuition Exchange.

In the event employment is terminated, any Tuition Exchange approved for children is also terminated.

ELIGIBLE CHILDREN

Undergraduate biological, foster, adopted and stepchildren residing with the employee for five consecutive years immediately prior to admission, who have not reached his or her 25th birthday by September 1, are eligible to apply. Pacific reserves the right to require documentation to confirm eligibility for children.

PROCESS

The application priority deadline for Tuition Exchange is November 1 prior to the student's attendance to the college or university. Pacific employees may apply on-line at www.tuitionexchange.org under the FAMILIES tab. Upon verification of eligibility, the application is submitted to the student's selected colleges or universities. Colleges and Universities typically notify students of approval or denial between March and May before the start of school. The Office of Financial Aid will also notify the employee once notification from the college or university is received.

RENEWALS

Eligibility is reviewed annually. In Spring, the Financial Aid Office will confirm the student's continual attendance and submit a recertification to the hosting school for the next academic year.

PURPOSE

Tuition Exchange enables eligible children of qualifying Pacific employees to apply for a Tuition Exchange scholarship at member colleges and universities which provides reduced tuition. ***Tuition Exchange scholarships are competitive and admission to the school does not guarantee a scholarship.***

OVERVIEW

University of the Pacific is a member of the Tuition Exchange program in association with other participating colleges and universities. Membership in the program requires that each institution maintain a balance between dependent children from the hosting institution (exports) and students coming from other institutions (imports); there are limited openings available.

Tuition Exchange Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis and is not a guaranteed award; scholarships are determined solely by the hosting school.
