JURIED AWARDS TO FUND A YEAR TO WRITE (A) SCREENPLAY(S). ENTRY SCREENPLAYS BY NO MORE THAN TWO AUTHORS; STAGE PLAYS ARE INELIGIBLE. ALUM OR UNDERGRAD OF ANY YEAR; FELLOWSHIP AWARDS TO STUDENTS ARE DEFERRED UNTIL STUDENT IS NO LONGER IN SCHOOL (APRIL DEADLINE).

Stipend, travel allowance, and ten week residency at Northwood University to develop a project in the arts, humanities, or sciences. Open to “individuals in any field or profession who wish to pursue an innovative project or creative idea” (December deadline).

[MacDowell Colony Residency](#)

For writers (literature and drama), composers, visual artists (including photographers, printmakers, filmmakers) and Interdisciplinary and collaborating artists; four to eight weeks of uninterrupted time and seclusion in which to work, in a community of gifted artists; emerging artists are encouraged to apply (September, January and April deadlines).

Annual fellowship for advanced study of Fine Arts in the U.S. or abroad, to enhance professional standing or to finance a special project; there are three fellowships of \$7,500 each in art, architecture or music; an additional music fellowship for \$15,000; and up to three alternate awards of up to \$1,000 each.

[Mister Rogers Memorial Scholarship](#)

The scholarship, in the amount of \$10,000, will be awarded annually to a qualified applicant. Candidates must have studied early childhood education, child development/child psychology, film/television production, music, animation, or some combination of at least two of these fields. In addition to the cash stipend, the recipient will receive mentoring support from members of the Academy's Children's Programming Peer Group, who will work with the recipient during the course of the academic year.
