[Canon Collins Educational Trust for Southern Africa \(CCETSA\)](#)

Full scholarships for nationals from southern African countries who wish to pursue a “postgraduate degree,” normally a one year master’s degree, in either in the U.K. or Southern Africa. The following scholarships are open only to South African nationals: Richard Turner Scholarship, Mamphela Ramphele/Chevening Scholarship, and Nelson Mandela Scholarship. The Chevening/CCETSA Scholarship is open only to Zimbabwean nationals. The Chevening/CCETSA/Leeds Scholarship is open to nationals from: Botswana, Lesotho, Mozambique, Namibia, South Africa, and Swaziland. and see the South/Southern Africa Scholarship Programme, also listed on the Collins Educational Trust website. (March deadline for U.K., August deadline for Southern Africa).

Funds graduate study for commonwealth citizens at commonwealth universities. Deadlines vary by country.

[Edmund Muskie Ph.D. Fellowship Program](#)

Funds doctoral level study in business administration, economics, public administration, and public policy for citizens of Georgia, the Russian Federation, and the Ukraine; must hold a master’s degree from a US institution.

[Rhodes Scholarships for Non-U.S. Citizens](#)

Study at oxford for citizens of Australia, Bangladesh, Bermuda, Canada, commonwealth Caribbean and Jamaica, Germany, Hong Kong, India, Kenya, Malaysia, New Zealand, Pakistan, Singapore, South Africa, Uganda, Zambia, and Zimbabwe (deadlines vary).
