[CESRI Fellowship](#) (Central Europe Summer Research Institute)

CESRI will provide awards for U.S. graduate students in the sciences and engineering with a high-quality international summer research experience in Austria, the Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Poland, or Slovakia. The CESRI program will be 8 weeks in length, with the first week spend as a group in Budapest, Hungary in a specially designed cultural and academic orientation to the region. Participants will spend the remaining 7 weeks working in individually-arranged placements in university labs or other appropriate sites where they can participate in creative research activities under the supervision of European mentors. All applicants must have U.S. citizenship or permanent residence in the U.S., and be a current master's or Ph.D. Student at an American university in one of the following fields: biology, chemistry, computer science, electrical engineering, environmental science, mathematics, or physics. German academic exchange service; funds undergraduate “study, thesis research, or internships” in Germany for four to ten months in all academic fields; depending on particulars, applicant may not need to demonstrate language competency. Sophomore or junior under 32 years of age (January deadline)

[Freeman-ASIA Award](#)

For study in Asia of at least eight weeks; priority to applicants with academic interest but no prior experience in Asia; any undergrad year (October deadline).

[German Chancellor Fellowship](#)

The Alexander von Humboldt Foundation offers prospective leaders from Brazil, China, India, Russia and the USA the opportunity to conduct a project as guests of the partner of their choice in Germany; during a four-week preparatory phase in Bonn and Berlin, you will be able to make contact with the other fellows; you will be invited to attend a reception at the German Chancellery, travel around Germany and visit important public institutions and companies; an intensive German course will help smooth your path into everyday life in Germany; the Chancellor of the Federal Republic of Germany is the patron of this fellowship program; the Foundation grants up to 50 German Chancellor Fellowships annually, with up to ten prospective leaders selected from each of the five countries.(September deadline)

[JISP Award](#) – Japan-IMF Scholarship Program for Advanced Studies

Funds first two years of doctoral study in economics for nationals of IMF Asian member countries; must be admitted to a PhD program in economics at a leading university in North America or Australia

[Organization of American States \(OAS\) Fellowships](#)

The OAS academic scholarship program, established in 1958, grants scholarships every year for the pursuit of master’s degrees, doctoral degrees and research leading to a degree in science and engineering; undergraduate scholarships are offered for full time studies in any English-speaking Caribbean member state; graduate scholarships are offered for full time studies in any OAS member state; additional scholarship opportunities to study in the countries of Brazil, Mexico and China
